RETURN TO GREEN LEVEL OF COVID-19 RECOVERY took place at midnight on July 30th. Archbishop Viennesau has circulated a memo indicating most of the restrictions placed on our gatherings can be removed. Wearing of masks, social distancing and mass registration will no longer be required and the church disinfection following mass can be discontinued. We should however respect those who wish to continue wearing masks. There 50% capacity restriction has been lifted and the church can now be filled for mass. Bishop Viennesau requested we continue to refrain from serving communion in the cup or directly on the tongue. He also asked we continue to refrain from shaking hands during the Rite of Peace.
